## CORONER'S INQUEST INTO THE DEATH OF CHERYL ANN BOUEY

BURNABY – The inquest into the death of Cheryl Ann Bouey has been scheduled. Ms. Bouey died in police custody in cells at the Prince George RCMP detachment on June 26, 2008.

The inquest is scheduled for Nov. 2-6, 2009. Presiding coroner Rodrick MacKenzie and a jury will publicly hear evidence from subpoenaed witnesses in order to determine the facts surrounding the death. The jury will have the opportunity to make recommendations aimed at preventing deaths under similar circumstances in the future.
