## **UPDATES**

- There has been an increase in personnel responding to the Big Bar Landslide incident. Along with additional resources in the Environmental unit, there has also been an increase in the number of scalers on the rockface.
- Unified Command is asking the public to refrain from entering areas near the landslide site. When the public enters an area of
  operation, they put themselves, our crews and others at risk. These incursions by members of the public not only pose a safety
  issue, but also slows our response efforts.
- The capture and transport operations continue to ramp up and remain successful. As of today approximately 4,700 Sockeye and Chinook salmon have been transported upstream from the slide.
