AMENDMENT NUMBER 3

Whereas the land described hereinafter is within Tree Farm Licence Number 18 and is found to be suitable for a higher economic use than the growing of forest crops;


And whereas the withdrawal of the aforementioned land will in no way affect the sustained yield management of the said Tree Farm Licence;

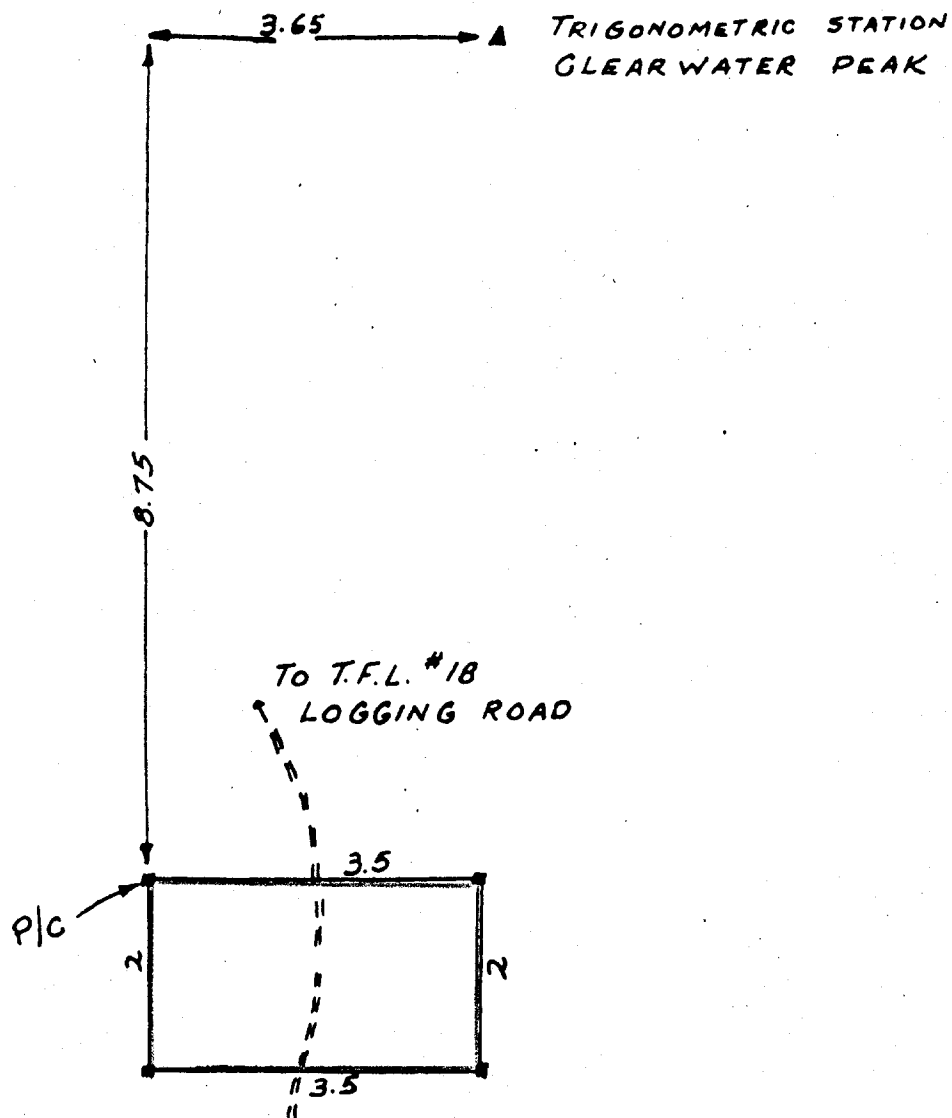
Therefore pursuant to Subsection (14) of Section 36 of the Forest Act being Chapter 153 of the Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1960, and pursuant to Clause 9 of the said Tree Farm Licence, the following land is herewith withdrawn from the lands described in Schedule "B" of the said Tree Farm Licence; namely, all that parcel or tract of land situated in Kamloops Division of Yale Land District as shown outlined in red on the sketch attached hereto and being more particularly described as follows:

"Commencing at a point 3.65 chains west and 8.75 chains south of the Trigonometric Station on Clearwater Peak; thence east 3.5 chains; thence south 2 chains; thence west 3.5 chains; thence north 2 chains more or less to the point of commencement."

and the land so withdrawn is and shall be henceforth no longer part of or subject to the said Tree Farm Licence Number 18 during the lifetime of Special Use Permit Number 5684 issued in respect of the aforementioned land.
