#### 1. Significant Accounting Policies

#### a. Purpose of the organization

#### i. Nature of organization

Pender Island Public Library (the society) has been designated as a not-for-profit organization on Pender Island, British Columbia, that provides a library, related services and meeting rooms for the community.

#### ii. Basis of accounting

The basis of accounting applied in the preparation of the financial information is on the historical cost basis, reflecting cash transactions, with the addition of the following:

- Equipment are amortized over their estimated useful life.
- Accounts payable and accrued liabilities.
- Current income taxes as at the reporting date.

#### b. Property, plant and equipment

Building improvements and equipment are carried at cost. Depreciation is calculated using the declining balance method over estimated useful lives. Signage, solar panel and heat pump are also recorded at cost and are amortized over their estimated useful lives usinhg straight line method. Depreciation expense for December 31, 2021 was \$ 24,021 (2020 - \$ 27,172).
