I. Executive Summary

The HPSA was established in 1999 as a federal not-for-profit profit corporation with an all-industry board consisting of brand owners of prescription drugs, non-prescription drugs, natural health products and medical sharps. The HPSA is a producer responsibility organization (PRO) that manages extended producer responsibility (EPR) medications and sharp collection programs in Canada.

Since 1997, the Health Products Stewardship Association (HPSA) has been managing, on behalf of its members, the British Columbia Medications Return Program (BCMRP) for Pharmaceuticals (prescription drugs, non-prescription drugs and natural health products) that are sold in the province of British Columbia through the "consumer/residential" waste stream. HPSA has leveraged its experience as a national PRO to bring promotion and education, material collection, end of life material management and regulatory knowledge to the BCMRP.

The program operates pursuant to the requirement of British Columbia Recycling Regulation (B.C. Reg. 449/2004) ("Regulation") under the Province's Environmental Mangement Act, as well as the Proposed British Columbia Medications Program Plan submitted to the Ministry covering January 1, 2012 to December 3, 2016. The latest amended proposed BCMRP plan was submitted to the Director in January 2021.

The BCMRP is designed to ensure that collection location sites are available throughout the province so that any unused and/or expired Pharmaceuticals returned by the public can, at no cost to the public, be properly collected, packaged, handled, transported and disposed of in a safe, compliant and environmentally responsible manner.

2020 has been a challenging year due to the pandemic. Although collected weights have decreased from 2019 (-6%), the collection network remained strong and even grew: in 2020, a total of 1,280 BC retail pharmacies or 92.15% of total accredited pharmacies in British Columbia were registered as HPSA collection sites (+ 5% from 2019).

HPSA would like to express its gratitude to the pharmacy community for supporting the BCMRP during these challenging times.

Since 1997, HPSA has established a comprehensive network of permanent collection sites under the BCMRP where the public can conveniently return pharmaceuticals. This network consists of community pharmacies. HPSA produces a Regional District Summary Report (Appendix 2) that shows the number of registered collection location sites per capita by district and demonstrates the high level of consumer access and program coverage in B.C. In 2020, HPSA undertook a GIS analysis to support the assessment of consumer access to Collection Location Sites. The analysis indicated a high level of accessibility with a population coverage of 99.2%. HPSA continued its partnership with BC First Nations Recycling Initiative (FNRI) with the view to support communities interested in starting a medication return program. In 2020, FNRI visited 16 Indigenous communities.

II. Program Outline

The Health Products Stewardship Association (HPSA) is a not-for-profit industry stewardship organization that meets its obligations as outlined in the BC extra provincial Society Act, and files the required reports with the Corporate Property Registry Branch of the Ministry of Finance. HPSA has been registered with Industry Canada since 2000.

HPSA has been appointed as the agency to meet pharmaceutical producer's regulatory obligations as established by BC *Recycling Regulation* 449/2004. On behalf of its members, HPSA performs certain duties required under the regulation. As of December 2020, HPSA's membership was established at 132 stewards (*Appendix 1*). The Program is accountable to its members, the general public and the government of British Columbia through the Ministry of Environment and Climate Change Strategy. The BCMRP performance is publicly accountable through the annual report.

The BCMRP is designed to capture unused and/or expired Pharmaceuticals from the residential sector. The Program includes products clearly attributable to an existing steward as well as orphan products (Pharmaceuticals that are no longer in production or the producer is no longer in business or Pharmaceuticals that were purchased outside of Canada) and "free riders" (Pharmaceuticals produced, imported or distributed by a manufacturer or a retailer that is not a registered member of HPSA).

HPSA provides all collection containers and collateral materials and pays all shipping and disposal costs. There is *no cost to the public or collection sites to participate*. The BC collection system has been designed with user convenience and flexibility in mind.

The collection sites for the *British Columbia Medications Return Program* are community pharmacies. Pharmacy managers interested in participating must complete and sign a Collection Location Agreement. Details on the program are provided to ensure that the manager and staff are knowledgeable on the program and its operations. All participating community pharmacies receive a guide containing instructions with information on the program for the public and handling of the medication containers.



III. Public Education Materials and Strategies

HPSA's promotional and educational strategies are designed to ensure B.C. residents know where and how to return unused and/or expired consumer health products.

A. Collection Location Sites

Upon registration, all HPSA collection location sites receive a package that contains the following consumer-related educational materials:

- Rack cards titled "Take It Back" and bookmarks titled "Don't Throw It Out" provide information on how the public should safely store and how and where to return unused and/or expired Pharmaceuticals (see *here*).
- A Pharmacist's Guide Medications Return Program. The Guide can be viewed *here*.

Promotional material order forms are available online *here*, enabling participating pharmacies and outside organizations such as municipalities and doctors' offices to order educational materials to be made available to the public.

Municipal Calendars: HPSA continues to promote the B.C. Medications Return Program in the recycling calendars published by regional districts and municipalities informing residents about municipal services.

In 2020, HPSA participated in the BC recycling guides with Recycle BC. A total of 265,298 calendars were distributed to Vancouver, North Vancouver, West Vancouver, RD of Central Kootenay, RD of Kootenay Boundary, RD of North Okanagan, Coquitlam, Prince George. In addition HPSA specifically place advertisement in District of Mission, Chiliwack and Penticton Recycling brochures reaching 40,000 households.

B. Website and Social Media

In 2020, HPSA continued its website "refresh" with an emphasis on regularly updating its Frequently Asked Questions section and improving the website's functionalities to better support prospective and existing collection sites. HPSA added a news banner to the website's front page to make information more accessible for consumers and pharmacies. The news banner is updated regularly with the latest news for the public and other stakeholders.


HPSA is also tracking the ranking and search engine optimization of the webpage. The web page currently has organic keywords that take consumers directly to the HPSA web page: "can I return medication to pharmacy", "returning medication".

One of HPSA's bilingual website's great functionality is its participating retail pharmacy locator tool for consumers, which allows visitors to enter their postal code to access a drop-down menu that provides the address and contact information of the nearest collection site. The searchable Collection Site Finder is at www.healthsteward.ca.



HPSA continues to post and keep its Facebook account current, using this social media platform to share best practices, HPSA videos, events (National Drug Drop-Off Month), articles and events from other health partners (such as the Community Pharmacist Network, ISMP or Drug Free Kids Canada).

As HPSA sees the value of growing its organization through social media, it is now present on additional social media platforms such as LinkedIn and Twitter. HPSA places efforts in growing the follower base and engaging with our stakeholders and the public. Industry-related organizations and professionals as well as consumers are present on the platforms mentioned above and this is reflected on post impressions and engagement.



HPSA's Twitter account is regularly mentioned and retweeted by various audience groups, from pharmacists to consumers and has an engagement rate of 3.7 %, which is fairly high for the industry.







C. National Campaigns

1) Institute for Safe Medication Practices Canada

In 2020, HPSA continued to work closely with the Institute for Safe Medication Practices Canada (ISMP), on empowering patients, families and healthcare providers with knowledge about risks of unused consumer medications and the disposal mechanisms available to them; on standardizing approaches to the disposal of unused medications in the home, using identified preferred practices; and on integrating messaging about medication returns into patient education materials in order to engage patients and families, and encourage the use of returns programs.

ISMP Canada used a variety of materials, messages and platforms to reinforce the message that safe management and disposal of unused, expired or unwanted products is important for patient safety, community safety and has a positive impact on our environment. Examples include:

- An ISMP Canada safety bulletin and consumer newsletter including educational messages about safe storage and disposal practices and medication returns programs.
- Information about safe storage and disposal of medications was included in a Digital Poster Campaign in 300 doctors' office waiting rooms across Canada. The information card reached an audience of more than 6 million people, with more than 23 million impressions, over a 12month period.

Below an overview of HPSA and ISMP Canada collaborative work undertaken in 2020.





2) Drug Free Kids Canada

HPSA's partnership with Drug Free Kids Canada continued in 2020. The not-for-profit has been drawing attention to prescription drug abuse and the need to keep children safe by calling on Canadians to drop-off unwanted Pharmaceuticals at their local pharmacies for safe disposal. In addition to TV, radio, digital and print executions, an array of social executions and shareable content, including lighthearted GIFs were developed and deployed in daily posts.

IV. Collection System and Accessibility

Community pharmacies currently participating in the program can be located by the public on the HPSA website at www.healthsteward.ca, or by accessing the Recycling Council of British Columbia's Recyclepedia app at www.rcbc.bc.ca. A list of all HPSA Collection Location Sites for 2020 can be found in Appendix 5.

In order to ensure that the program provides "reasonable" consumer access to collection facilities, as required under Section 5 (1) (c) (iii) of the Regulation, HPSA undertook a study of its accessibility in British Columbia. The GIS analysis of coverage for the Province of British Columbia was completed in November 2020 to support the assessment of Consumer Access to Collection Location Sites (retail pharmacies participating in the HPSA network). The scenario model chosen was slightly different to that of the SABC accessibility criteria with the drive time shorter.

At the time of the study, HPSA had 1,242 Collection Location Sites registered with the Association. Of those, 854 are urban locations with the remaining 388 located in rural areas. Using this collection network, population coverage within the drive time distances was calculated. Drive time circles were used for this calculation.

In order to calculate the statistics, the locations and population coverage of the 1,242 pharmacies were analyzed. The 2016 Canadian Census was the basis for the calculations. As the table indicates, provincial population coverage was 99.2%. The Rural classification had 97.6% coverage. Urban results indicate full coverage at 99.9% of possible population. Both of these measures indicate a high level of accessibility.



V. Pollution Prevention Hierarchy and Product/Component Management

The pollution prevention hierarchy requirements outlined in the *Recycling Regulation* to reduce the environmental impact are not applicable for pharmaceuticals: due to their nature and inherent health and safety risks, there is no reuse or recycling option available for these products.

In 2020, HPSA disposed 100% of the unused and expired Pharmaceuticals collected in British Columbia through incineration at Suez (Alberta).

VI. Products Sold and Collected and Recovery Rate

HPSA produces an Regional District Summary Report - see *Appendix 2* - that shows the number of registered collection location sites per capita by Regional District and demonstrates the high level of consumer access and program coverage in British Columbia.

Medications may have a long delay between the time of purchase and return and prescription drugs should be fully consumed unless otherwise directed by a health professional. The *Medications Return Program* collects medications, not the bottle or vial used to market the product or used to dispense the prescription. HPSA recommends that containers be recycled by the consumer via the provincial blue box program.

In 2020, the average volume of post-consumer pharmaceuticals returned per capita was 0.0179 kg representing a total volume of 93,905.5 kg of pharmaceuticals returned for disposal. The highest volume of return for a regional district was Metro Vancouver at 44,087.60 kg followed by Capital at 10,963.70 kg. Table 1 shows 2020 Volume collected per capita by regional districts.







A reasonable assurance engagement also includes assessing the suitability in the circumstances of management's use of applicable criteria, applied as explained in Appendix 1 of this report, as the basis for preparing information required by Section 8(2)(b), (d), (e) and (g) of the Recycling Regulation; evaluating the appropriateness of quantification methods and reporting policies used, and the reasonableness of estimates made by management; and evaluating the overall presentation of the information detailed within the annual report and accompanying Appendix 1 and 2.

We believe the evidence we obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion. Relevant information required by Section 8(2)(b), (d), (e) and (g) of the Recycling Regulation is set out in Appendix 1 and 2 of this report.

Our Independence and Quality Control

In addition, as discussed in Appendix 2 of this report, Health Products Stewardship Association has not reported the recovery rate and its performance for the year ending December 31, 2020 and, therefore, we are unable to express an opinion on these items.

Qualified Opinion

In our opinion, except for the effects of the matters described in the Basis for Qualified Opinion paragraph, Health Products Stewardship Association's information for the year ended December 31, 2020, is prepared, in all material respects, in accordance with the applicable criteria.
