CORONER'S INQUEST INTO THE DEATH OF ALBERT WILLIAM PREVOST

BURNABY – The inquest into the death of Albert William Prevost has been scheduled. On March 14, 2008, Mr. Prevost was in medical distress while in the custody of Port Hardy RCMP. Emergency medical services transported Mr. Prevost to the Port Hardy Hospital. He was later transported to Campbell River and District General Hospital, where despite medical treatment he died on March 23, 2008.

The inquest is scheduled for May 19-21, 2009. Presiding coroner Shane DeMeyer and a jury will publicly hear evidence from subpoenaed witnesses in order to determine the facts surrounding the death. The jury will have the opportunity to make recommendations aimed at preventing deaths under similar circumstances in the future.
