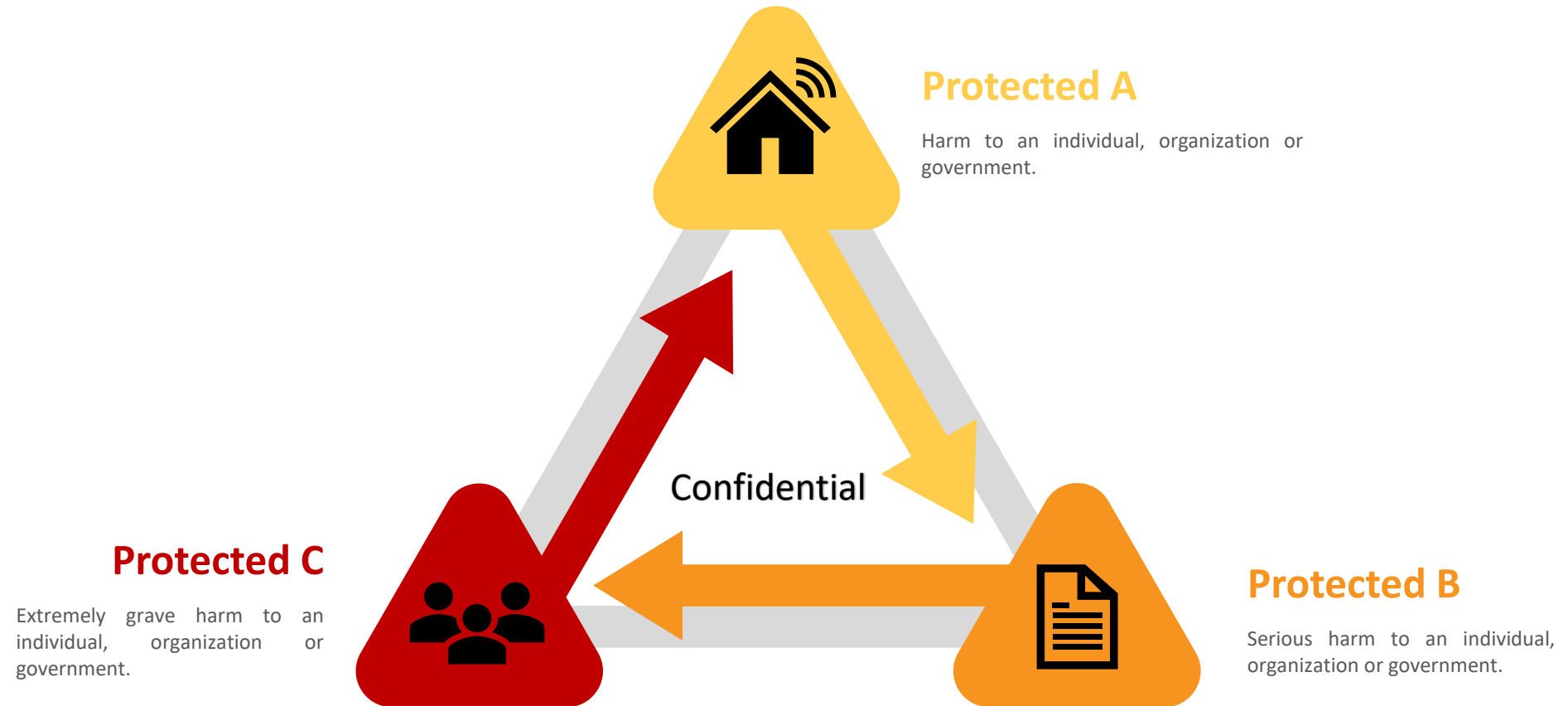

## **Protected A**

Home addresses, dates of birth, other low-risk personal information



## **Protected B**

Law enforcement and medical records, personnel evaluations and investigations, financial records, information subject to solicitor-client privilege or other legal privilege



## **Protected C**

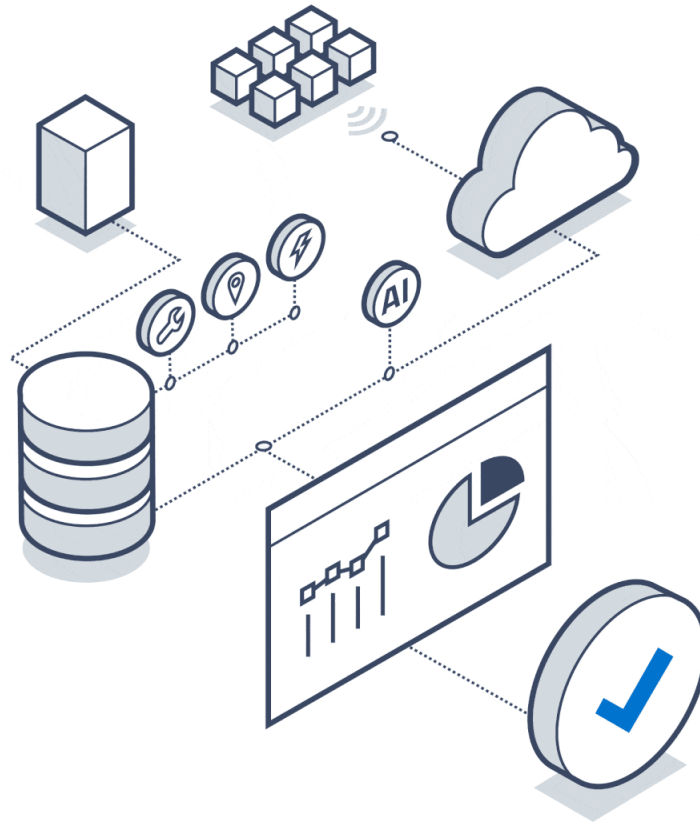
Information about police agents and other informants, Cabinet records or Cabinet-related records
