EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA 30.001.1973

Pursuant to the Mineral Act and Placer-mining Act, and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

(1) No person may locate a mineral claim, placer-mining claim or placer-mining lease in or upon the following described lands in the Vancouver Mining Division, New Westminster Land District:

Commencing at a point approximately 10.5 chains east and 27 chains south of the southwest corner of T.L. 3067, New Westminster District; thence south 44° 30' east 10 chains; thence south 45° 30' west 6 chains; thence north 44° 30' west 10 chains; thence north 45° 30' east 6 chains more or less to the point of commencement

and

(2) On and after the expiry of any existing mineral claim, placer-mining claim or lease the location of which lies within these lands, no person may locate in or upon any area comprised in the location, and that this Order comes into operation with respect to each such location upon expiry.
