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British Columbia export values are down -19% for September 2019 year to date (YTD) compared to the same period in 2018 (\$9.3 billion vs \$11.5 billion)

- Lumber export Value is down -26% while volumes are down -13%. The value of Other Wood Products is down -7% while log exports YTD are also down (-9%).
- *Pulp and paper export* Pulp value is down -20% and the value of paper products is also down (-6%).
- Value by destination United States (-22%), China (-12%), Japan (-20%) and other countries (-21%) are all down in September 2019 YTD.

- Export Softwood Lumber Product Value Share (Table 1) YTD September 2019 product value share of softwood lumber was 40% compared to 44% the same period last year.
- Value by Country (Table 2) United States YTD share of value is down from 47% in September 2018 to 45% in September 2019. China's share of value YTD is up from 27% last year to 29% in September 2019.
- Quantities to China (Table 10) Compared to the same period last year, YTD export volumes to China are up.
  Softwood lumber volumes increased by +4%, pulp by +8% and logs by +7% YTD September 2019. However, overall value of YTD exports to china is down -12%.


Figure 1: Total Export Value \$16.0 \$1.6 Monthly Value (lines), C\$ billions \$1.4 \$14.0 \$1.2 \$1.0 \$0.8 \$0.6 \$0.4 \$0.2 \$2.0 \$0.0 \$0.0 1104 OCL 404 Max POL 2018 - YTD 2019 - YTD ••• 2018 - Monthly 2019 - Monthly




Figure 8: Other Wood Export Value -12 Month Moving Sum \$3.0 Month Moving Sum, C\$ billions \$2.5 \$2.0 \$1.5 \$1.0 \$0.5 \$0.0 12 | 2011 2012 2013 2014 2015 2016 2017 United States · · · · · Other → Total








Figure 10: Paper Export Value -




Figure 17: Pulp Export Quantity




Figure 19: Logs Export Quantity




Figure 20: Log Export Quantity - 12 Month Moving Sum
