CORONER'S INQUEST INTO THE DEATH OF ROSS ALEXANDER ALLAN

BURNABY – The inquest into the death of Ross Alexander Allan has been scheduled. Mr. Allan died at Matsqui-Sumas-Abbotsford (MSA) General Hospital on April 15, 2008.

The inquest is scheduled for June 1-12, 2009. Presiding coroner Liana Wright and a jury will publicly hear evidence from subpoenaed witnesses in order to determine the facts surrounding the death. The jury will have the opportunity to make recommendations aimed at preventing deaths under similar circumstances in the future.
