WHAT IS THE KNOWLEDGE AND TECHNOLOGY TRANSFER PROGRAM (KTTP)?

The cost-shared reimbursement program is intended to strategically support extension activities for B.C.'s producers and processors to innovate and adapt to changing environmental, production, and market conditions through practical, applied knowledge and skill development.

The KTTP opened three intakes this year. This report notes the Spring and Fall intakes only.

OBJECTIVE

The objective of the KTTP is to increase the competitiveness, resiliency, and innovation of the B.C. agriculture and food sector through facilitated knowledge and technology transfer.




