
Green Solution or New Year's Resolution?

Navigating our **Shopping Cart**

1. What is current?

Although the Distribution Centre Victoria has a printed catalogue, the most current up to date products and pricing are found online.

2. What is the unit of issue?

The unit of issue is how a product is sold. It can be found on the cart located next to the price of the product. The description may say 12 per box, but sold by each so it's important to look at unit of issue.

3. What if I need to make a change in my order?

There is a very small window available if you need to make a change to an already submitted order. If you need to add or subtract a product, change the ship to or cancel the whole thing call our customer service staff at 250-952-4460.

4. Who can order Protocol and Specialty Giftware?

Protocol and Specialty giftware can be ordered by government ministries, employees and government entities.

5. What is a Registered Expense Authority?

Formally known as a Spending Authority, a Registered Expense Authority approves or disproves Distribution Centre Victoria electronic orders sent to their email address from the initiator of the order. If an expense authority wishes to approve an order, they click on the "Reply" icon, type, "Approved", and then click, "Send". If an expense authority does not wish to authorize an order, they click on the "Delete" icon and as a result, the order will not be received by the DCV.
