POSITION: Member – Elder Representative

REPORTS TO: Chair of the Minister's Advisory Council on Indigenous Women

<u>Purpose</u>

In addition to the key responsibilities laid out in the Member position description, the Elder Representative carries out additional duties related to the responsibilities and governance of the Council.

Key Responsibilities

- Guide MACIW and MIRR towards a knowledgeable, respectful approach to working with, and building connections within, Indigenous and Elder communities
- Bring Elders' issues or concerns to the attention of MACIW
- Act as a cultural advisor
- Provide wise guidance and sound judgment
- Teach and correct others in kind and respectful ways

Working Conditions

A Member can expect to dedicate 10 hours per month to her role, in addition to quarterly (4), two-day meetings. Additional meetings may be convened, as determined by the Chair or the Minister. Members are compensated at a rate of \$250 per day, as pre-approved by the Secretariat. Travel expenses are reimbursed according to provincial government rates.

Skills and Abilities

- Comprehensive knowledge of Indigenous histories, cultures and peoples, with aparticular understanding of Elders' lived experiences
- Active and respected within the Indigenous community as an Elder
- Deeply committed to sharing knowledge, providing guidance and teaching others
- Sees the goodness in others and encourages them to reach their optimum potential

- Integrity
