Licensed Guide Outfitters and resident hunters with a valid Permit to Accompany (PTA) may purchase hunting licences on behalf of a non-resident or non-resident alien hunter. The guide outfitter licence or PTA must have been issued previously for the eLicensing system to allow the sale.





Step 2 – Buying on Behalf of a Youth (Non-Resident /alien)

- Select **Purchase Type** (Buying on Behalf of a Youth)
- Fill in the youth's **FWID, Last Name, and First Initial**, then click **SEARCH**
- If youth profile is found, Last Name and First Initial of the youth will appear
- Select Agent for the Relationship to Youth
- Select the **Licence Type** for the youth
- Before buying a non-resident hunting licence on behalf of a youth, a parent or legal guardian must complete and **sign the written undertaking form**
- Ask the guide outfitter or parent/guardian to provide the written undertaking form that has been completed and signed by the parent/legal guardian
- **Click the box** to confirm you have received a signed written undertaking form
- **Retain the form** – it must be submitted to Service BC vendor managing office
- **Click the box** to confirm that you have been authorized to submit applications on behalf of the youth.
- **Click the box** to confirm that you have received a hunting licence application signed by the parent or guardian
- **Retain the application form** – it must be submitted to Service BC vendor manager



In addition, the holder of the cancelled hunting licence will remain ineligible to obtain a hunting licence for the remainder of the licence year (*Wildlife Act's* Hunting Licensing Regulation s.15), or until such time as the fine(s) is paid in full, whichever is later.

Step 8 – Print Expiry Year, Name and FWID on Species Licence Stub

- Print clearly the FWID and First Name and Last Name of the hunter.

Glossary of Terms

Big Game – as defined in the *Wildlife Act* (RSBC 1996 c.488), means

- (a) any member of the family Cervidae,
- (b) mountain sheep, mountain goat, bison or pronghorn antelope,
- (c) bear, cougar or wolf, or
- (d) a mammal prescribed as big game.

Fish and Wildlife ID (FWID) – a personalized identification number obtained when an individual registers in the Wildlife Information and Licensing Data (WILD) system. The FWID is linked to an electronic profile that includes the user's personal information, credentials, licences, permits, applications and limited entry hunting authorizations.

Guide Outfitter – means a person licensed as a guide outfitter under the *Wildlife Act* (RSBC 1996 c.488).

Non-resident: as defined in the *Wildlife Act* (RSBC 1996 c.488), means

- (a) A person who is not a resident but is a Canadian citizen or a permanent resident of Canada, or
- (b) A person who i. is not a resident, but whose only or primary residence is in Canada, and
ii. has resided in Canada for the 12 month period immediately before making an application under the *Wildlife Act* or doing another thing relevant to the operation of the *Wildlife Act*.

Non-Resident Alien – as defined in the *Wildlife Act* (RSBC 1996 c.488), means a person who is neither a B.C. resident nor a non-resident.

Permit to Accompany – permit issued under section 70(1)(a) of the *Wildlife Act* that authorizes a resident hunter to accompany up to two non-resident or non-resident alien hunters while hunting big game in B.C.

Restricted Hunting Licence - is a licence issued to a non-resident/alien who has not successfully completed training, approved by the director, about conservation, outdoor recreation and safety. If they hold a restricted non-resident/alien licence, they must be accompanied by a guide outfitter, assistant guide outfitter or permit to accompany holder while hunting small game as well as big game.

Small Game - includes fox, raccoon, coyote, skunk, snowshoe hare and game birds.

Unrestricted Hunting Licence - is a licence issued to a non-resident/alien who has successfully completed training, approved by the director, about conservation, outdoor recreation and safety. Non-resident/alien hunters wishing to hunt small game may do so unaccompanied if they hold an unrestricted non-resident/alien licence.

Upland Game Birds: includes the gallinaceous birds, such as wild turkey, grouse, partridge, ptarmigan, pheasant, and quail. Non-residents/alien are required to obtain an upland game bird licence.

Youth – persons 10 years of age or older, and under 18.

Youth licence – a hunting licence issued to a parent or legal guardian on behalf of a child or ward in accordance with section 17.1 (2) of the Wildlife Act.
