EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA 14 NOV 1974

Pursuant to the Mineral Act and Placer Mining Act, and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

- (1) No person shall locate or mine upon the following described lands in the New Westminster Mining Division, Yale Division of Yale Land District and Group 2, New Westminster Land District:

Commencing at a point on the southerly boundary of Section 26, Tp. 1, Range 29, W6M, said point being 17 chains east of the southwest corner of said Section 26; thence due south 22 chains; thence due west 34 chains; thence due north 32 chains; thence due east 34 chains more or less to a point due north of the aforesaid point of commencement; thence south 10 chains more or less to said point of commencement.

and

- (2) On and after the expiry of any existing mineral claim, placer-mining claim or lease the location of which lies within these lands, no person may locate or mine in or upon any area comprised in the location, and that this Order comes into operation with respect to each such location upon expiry.
