recommend

THAT pursuant to the Mineral Act and Placer-mining
Act and all other powers thereunto enabling, no person may
locate or mine in or upon the following described lands in
the Cariboo Mining Division, Cariboo Land District:

East half of Lot 9332

except in accordance with and subject to the following terms
and conditions:

No holder of a mineral claim, or placer-mining claim
or lease that may hereafter be located within the area
outlined above, shall be entitled to any surface or
timber rights whatsoever:

AND TO FURTHER RECOMMEND THAT upon the expiry of any
mineral claim, placer-mining claim or lease which lies within
the area outlined above, the lands covered by any such mineral
claim, placer-mining claim or lease shall become and are hereby
consecrated a reservation under the terms of this order.


