INTRODUCTION

The following is an executive summary of Product Care's Post-Consumer Stewardship Programs for paint and residuals collected during the period from January 1, 2002 to December 31, 2002.

PAINT COLLECTED DURING 2002

5.4 million equivalent litre containers (elc's **) Note: elc's is a standardized measure of the container capacity in litres collected in Product Care tubskids.

Cumulative total to date: (1994-2002) 27.9 million elc's

** Equivalent litre containers or elc's is a standardized measurement used by Product Care that is based on the capacity of containers collected by the program.

PRODUCT CARE COLLECTION FACILITIES (As of December 31, 2002)

Product Care maintains a system of more than 100 depots in BC. All depots accept paint, while 35 of these depots, known as Multi-Drop Depots, also accept flammable liquids, pesticide and gasoline.

CONTAINER MANAGEMENT

Product Care tries to recycle containers whenever possible. Under scrap-metal-market conditions, Product Care was able to recycle approximately half of the 518 tonnes of metal containers collected during 2002.
