
Permit to Accompany Report



Required when:	The report is required when the Hunt End Date on a Permit to Accompany has passed. The report must be submitted no more than 10 days after the Hunt End Date.
Who is eligible to submit?	The holder of a Permit to Accompany
Royalties (these will make up the report fee)	 Mountain Sheep - \$250 Mountain Goat - \$150 Moose - \$125 Elk - \$125 Caribou - \$125 Cougar - \$125 Black Bear - \$75 Deer - \$50 Wolf - \$50



Before you start

Before you submit a Permit to Accompany Report, make sure you have:

- An active Fish and Wildlife ID
- A Permit to Accompany for which the hunt end date has passed.

Log in to your Fish and Wildlife profile from the B.C. Hunting homepage at www.gov.bc.ca/hunting.

Next, click on **Permit to Accompany** under **Reports** on the left-hand side of your profile home page.

• Click **CREATE NEW** to start a new report





Hunt Information


- Record hunt information for each animal hunted by clicking ADD HUNT INFORMATION
- If a species requiring a Compulsory Report
 (CR) is harvested, you will have the *option* to
 submit the CR on behalf of the hunter if one
 has not already been submitted. If you
 submit a CR on behalf of the accompanied
 hunter, they will see the report on their FWID
 profile.
- When all hunt information has been entered, review for errors, then check the attestation checkbox and click SUBMIT

NOTE: All hunt details for each species hunted in each wildlife management unit must be included, even if no harvest occurred.

After submission

- Once your report has been submitted, if you have royalties owing you can choose to pay for them right away, or at a later date.
- The invoice can be viewed by clicking on the **Invoice** link (if applicable).
- The report document can be downloaded by clicking on the **Report ID** link.

NOTES:

It may take 10 seconds for the Report ID link to show. You may need to refresh the page to see the link.

Royalties are due within 30 days after the hunt end date specified on the permit.

Once a report has been submitted, it cannot be modified online. If modifications are required contact FrontCounter BC.
