Hazardous Materials Regulations: Private Vehicle

Applicable to vehicles travelling on inland ferries, excluding the François Lake Ferry, Upper Arrow Lake Ferry, Needles Cable Ferry.

Find your vehicle type below for your private vehicle hazardous material limits and regulations.

Truck & Camper



Propane: Up to 2 cylinders attached to a regulator & secured in the recreational unit, with a total volume of up to 65L. You may carry an extra cylinder for an unattached BBQ (must not exceed 65L).

Gasoline: 1 jerrycan of no more than 25L.

Camping Fuel: Maximum 5L of Kerosene.

Firearms / Ammunition: Stored as required by Federal Firearms Regulations.

SCUBA Equipment: Must be declared to terminal attendant/crew (no limit).

Travel Trailer (Any Size)



Propane: Up to 2 cylinders attached to a regulator & secured in the recreational unit, with a total volume of up to 65L. You may carry an extra cylinder for an unattached BBQ (must not exceed 65L).

Gasoline: 1 jerrycan in towing vehicle + 2 jerrycans in trailer of no more than 25L each.

Camping Fuel: Maximum 5L of Kerosene.

Firearms / Ammunition: Stored as required by Federal Firearms Regulations.

SCUBA Equipment: Must be declared to terminal attendant/crew (no limit).

Fifth Wheel (Any Size)



Propane: Up to 2 cylinders attached to a regulator & secured in the recreational unit, with a total volume of up to 65L. You may carry an extra cylinder for an unattached BBQ (must not exceed 65L).

Gasoline: 1 jerrycan in towing unit, 2 jerry cans in trailer of no more than 25L each.

Camping Fuel: Maximum 5L of Kerosene.

Firearms / Ammunition: Stored as required by Federal Firearms Regulations.

SCUBA Equipment: Must be declared to terminal attendant/crew (no limit).

Motorhome (Any Size)



Propane: Up to 2 cylinders attached to a regulator & secured in the recreational unit, with a total volume of up to 65L. You may carry an extra cylinder for an unattached BBQ (must not exceed 65L).

Gasoline: 1 jerrycan of no more than 25L.

Camping Fuel: Maximum 5L of Kerosene.

Firearms / Ammunition: Stored as required by Federal Firearms Regulations.

SCUBA Equipment: Must be declared to terminal attendant/crew (no limit).

Toy Hauler (Any Size)



Propane: Up to 2 cylinders attached to a regulator & secured in the recreational unit, with a total volume of up to 65L. You may carry an extra cylinder for an unattached BBQ (must not exceed 65L).

Gasoline: 1 jerrycan in towing unit, 2 jerry cans in trailer of no more than 25L each. Factory on-board tank filled to manufactures labeled capacity.

Camping Fuel: Maximum 5L of Kerosene.

Firearms / Ammunition: Stored as required by Federal Firearms Regulations.

SCUBA Equipment: Must be declared to terminal attendant/crew (no limit).

Vehicle & Boat (Any Size)



Propane: Up to 2 cylinders if attached to a regulator & secured in the recreational unit, with a total volume of up to 65L. You may carry an extra cylinder for an unattached BBQ (must not exceed 65L).

Gasoline: 1 jerrycan of no more than 25L in towing unit, 2 jerry cans in boat of no more than 25L each. Factory on-board tank filled to manufactures labeled capacity.

Camping Fuel: Maximum 5L of Kerosene.

Firearms / Ammunition: Stored as required by Federal Firearms Regulations.

SCUBA Equipment: Must be declared to terminal attendant/crew (no limit).

Vehicle & Trailered / Loaded Vehicles (ATV, car, etc.)



Propane: 1 cylinder must not exceed 65L.

Gasoline: 1 jerrycan in towing vehicle + 2 jerrycans in trailer of no more than 25L each.

Camping Fuel: Maximum 5L of Kerosene.

Firearms / Ammunition: Stored as required by Federal Firearms Regulations.

SCUBA Equipment: Must be declared to terminal attendant/crew (no limit).
