

No Staking

THAT the reserve established under the Mineral Act and Placer-mining Act by Order-in-Council 641, approved 24 February, 1971 be cancelled in so far as it applies to Lots 158, 174, 175, 176, 177, 178, 179 and 180, Sooke Land District;

THAT pursuant to the Mineral Act and Placer-mining Act and all other powers thereunto enabling no person may locate or mine in or upon the following described lands in the Victoria Mining Division, Sooke Land District:

Commencing at the south west corner of Lot 77; thence north 83° west 164 chains more or less to a point due north of Bill Head; thence south westerly in a straight line to the high water mark on the most southerly extremity of Billings Pt.; thence westerly in a straight line to the south east corner of Lot 72; thence southerly in a straight line to the north west corner of Lot 180; thence southerly along the westerly boundary of said Lot 180 to the south west corner thereof; thence south 17° east 144 chains; thence south 65° east to a point due south of the most easterly south east corner of Lot 109; thence north to said corner; thence north easterly along the easterly boundaries of Lots 109, 130, 131 to the north east corner of Lot 131; thence north westerly along the northerly boundary of said Lot 131 to a point where the south westerly extension of the easterly boundary of Lot 124 intersects the northerly boundary of Lot 131; thence north easterly in a straight line to the southerly corner of Lot 124; thence westerly along the southerly boundary of said Lot 124 to its intersection with the easterly boundary of Lot 77; thence southerly and westerly along the easterly and southerly boundaries of said Lot 77 to the south west corner thereof, being the point of commencement.
