Dear Minister Popham:

Re: Animal Activism and Orderly Marketing in Regulated Agriculture

Several livestock commodity boards and commissions (boards) have again raised concerns regarding trespass by animal activists on farms and private property of producers, to the attention of the BC Farm Industry Review Board (BCFIRB). The concerns range from producers' fears about the safety and welfare of their families, themselves and their animals, to property damage, disruption of livelihoods, risks of a serious biosecurity event and potential impacts to the food supply chain and food security.

BCFIRB agrees that these concerns represent significant implications to orderly marketing and the public interest.

We understand that yourself, along with Ministers Eby and Farnworth, announced, at BC Agriculture Day in October 2019, that the issues associated with trespass and animal activism on BC farms would be examined and addressed. We appreciate that the legal, policy and enforcement issues involved are complex and are still under assessment, in consultation with various industry representatives.

Please let me know if there is any assistance that BCFIRB can provide the Ministry of Agriculture, Food and Fisheries to help move these matters forward. BCFIRB members have suggested that amending the Farm Practices Protection (Right to Farm) Act to address some of the concerns raised may be an option for exploration. BCFIRB staff would be pleased to support any discussions or analysis as appropriate.
