Draft CNAR Requirements – Due March 31st!

As in previous years, you are required to submit a draft CNAR ministry parent to review your climateactionsecretariat@gov.bc.ca. You must use the CNAR Overview Template to provide a general description or broad summary of actions taken in 2013. If your organization emitted less than 600 tonnes of emissions in 2012, you may use the Small Emitters Short Form instead. Both of these documents are available as Word Documents in the Documents Library on the Carbon Neutral Corner. No other content is required until the final report is due on May 30th. No signature or emissions data is required so those parts of the template can be left blank until the final report.

EDX Update and Call for EDX Pilot Volunteers

Progress continues with the development of new functionality that will enable <u>SMARTTool</u> users to receive their FortisBC data electronically. FortisBC and SSBC are now testing the send/receive functionality with data supplied by Public Sector Organizations who have volunteered their data. This work is expected to be completed in mid-March. Thank you to School Districts 35 and 44, Vancouver Coastal Health Authority and the District of North Cowichan.

At the same time, SSBC continues its work on the development of <u>SMARTTool</u> self-serve screens that will enable users to manage their own configurations. This work will be complete in May when a Pilot phase will begin with a representative sample of <u>SMARTTool</u> users who will have the opportunity to "test drive" all of the new functionality.
