#### **Operational updates**

The Falls Creek Alliance mobilized to site and set up office trailers to facilitate construction. Utility relocation was completed, embankment and excavating work is underway, and pile driving has begun. While the team is working hard to optimize traffic queues and wait times, those travelling through the site should expect an average wait time of 30-45 minutes as Single Lane Alternating Traffic (SLAT) continues.

- Please obey traffic control personnel.


