(1) No person may locate a mineral claim, placer-mining claim or placer-mining lease in or upon the following described lands in the Vancouver Mining Division, New Westminster Land District:

Commencing at a point approximately 12.5 chains east and 34 chains south of the southwest corner of T.L. 3284P, New Westminster District; thence south 71° 30' east 27 chains; thence south 18° 30' west 10 chains; thence north 71° 30' west 27 chains; thence north 18° 30' east 10 chains more or less to the point of commencement:
