All those lands situated in the Yale Land District, being more particularly described as

"An area one quarter mile on either side of the centre line of the proposed Westcoast Transmission Company Limited pipeline commencing at a point where the said centre line intersects the right bank of the Coquihalla River in the vicinity of Hope; thence in a general easterly and north-easterly direction along the route of the said pipeline to a point where it intersects the Kettle Valley Railroad in the vicinity of Coquihalla Station; as shown on the maps attached hereto."
