## RE: APPEALS FROM THE IMPLEMENTATION OF BRITISH COLUMBIA CHICKEN MARKETING BOARD ORDER #313

On December 9, 1998, the Panel heard a further request for a stay, from the penalties imposed by Order #313, from Mr. Bayne Vance. Mr. and Mrs. Norm Wilson, although originally seeking this remedy were unavailable to attend the telephone conference and advised by fax that they had already made adequate submissions with respect to this issue. Mr. Bandali, who was aware of the application, did not attend and made no representations.

The Panel heard a similar application by written submission on September 24, 1998 and ruled that as there was no evidence of irreparable harm and as the hearing was to be heard in October, the balance of convenience did not favour a stay.

This matter is now half completed and scheduled to resume in the first week of January 1999. Given that and the admission of Mr. Vance that he does not intend to grow chicken until May of 1999, the Panel is satisfied that in all circumstances a stay is inappropriate. In addition, there is nothing with respect to the particular circumstances of Luck of the Draw Broiler Farm which causes this Panel to alter its earlier decision.

Accordingly, the application for a stay of the penalty provisions of Order #313 is denied.
