Briefly describe the top three actions taken by your organization in 2017 to reduce GHG emissions and/or improve sustainability from its operations:

Replaced five vehicles with more fuel-efficient units in 2017. Continued use of the FOB Authentication, Printer Defaults set to duplex and black & white printing, and RightFax system to reduce both paper and printer use. Paper use between 2016 and 2017 was reduced by an additional 11% (reduced by 43% previous year) Copies printed between 2016 and 2017 was reduced by an additional 10% (reduced by 18% previous year)

3. Reduced fleet fuel consumption between 2016 and 2017 by 1% (reduced by 5% previous year).

Briefly describe plans your organization has for continuing to reduce your GHG emissions in future years:

GHG Reduction Plans for 2018

- Vehicle Fleet
 - Plan to replace two vehicles with more fuel efficient units
 - Plan to add two new vehicles to the fleet (adding to remote locations to accommodate BP initiatives)
 - Plan to add one three-ton truck to the fleet (purchase 3-Ton to replace rental 5-ton). Attempting to replace with gas powered engine if feasible.
- Paper Consumption and Print/Copy Fleet
 - Continue to utilize the FOB Authentication, Printer Defaults and RightFax system to reduce GHGs.
 - Review the existing print fleet in October 2018; intend to reduce fleet by approximately 7 MFDs (Commission-wide)
- New Victoria Facility
 - Move Victoria staff into a new office in October 2018. Expect to see a significant reduction in utilities/energy consumption once we begin operating in a well-performing facility that has been designed and built according to LEED Gold standards.
 - The new office space will also be built in compliance with ASHRAE standards for commercial buildings.

The Organization hereby agrees that, in exchange for the Ministry of Environment and Climate Change Strategy ensuring that these offsets are retired on the Organization's behalf, the Organization will pay the associated invoice to be issued by the Ministry in an amount equal to \$25 per tonne of offsets retired on its behalf plus GST.
