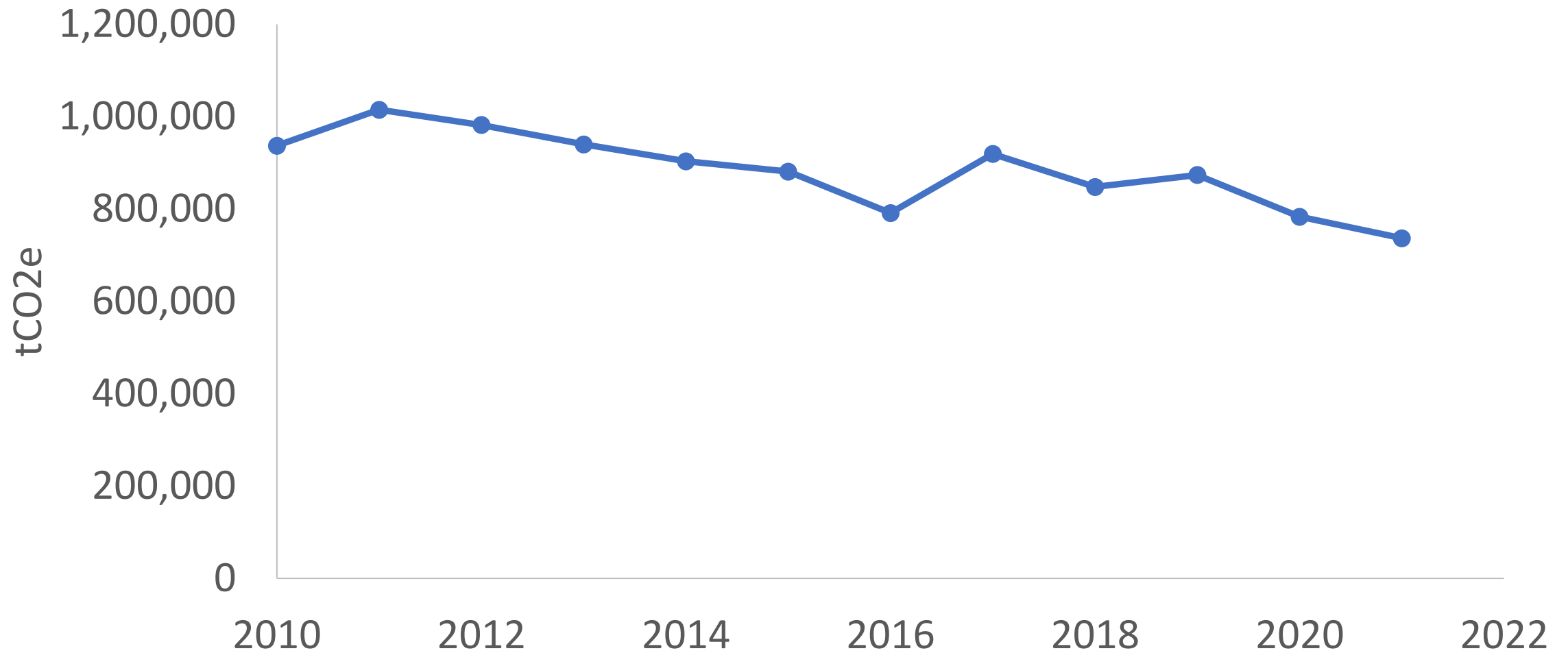

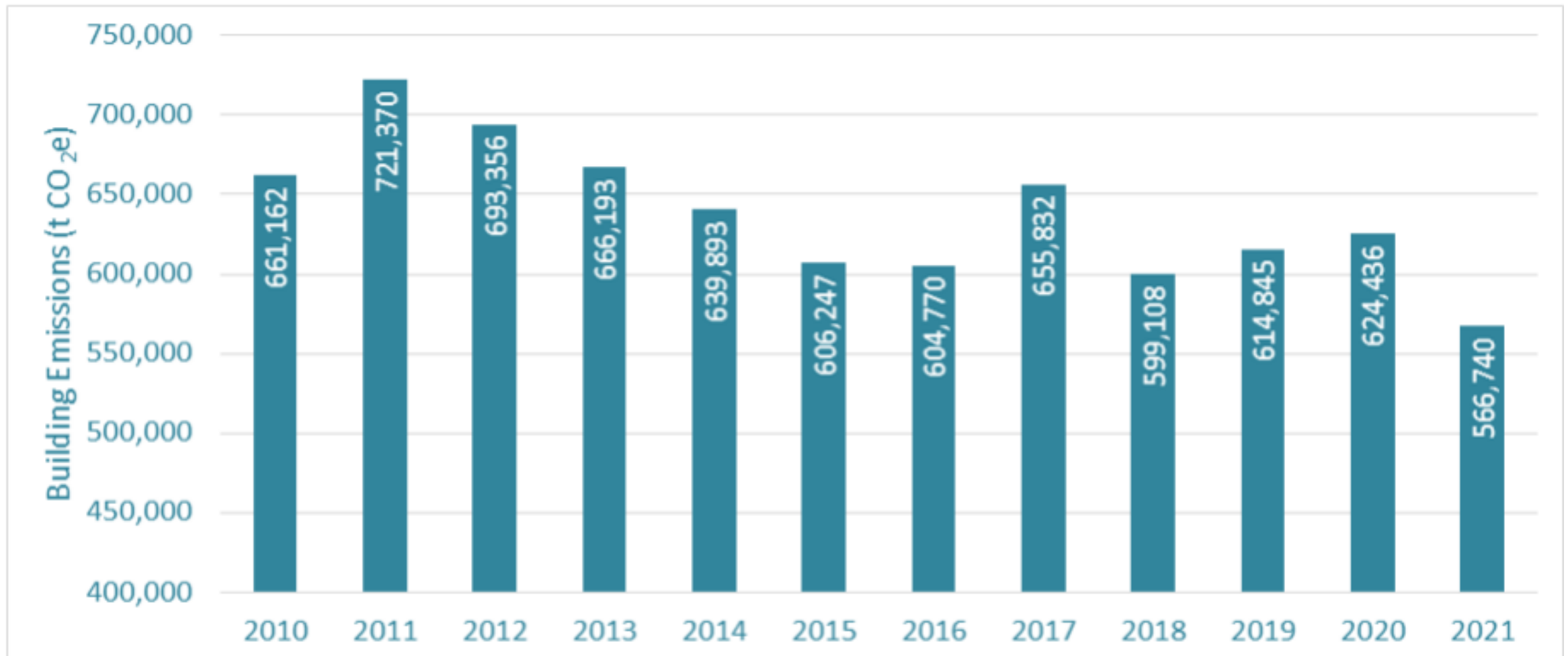

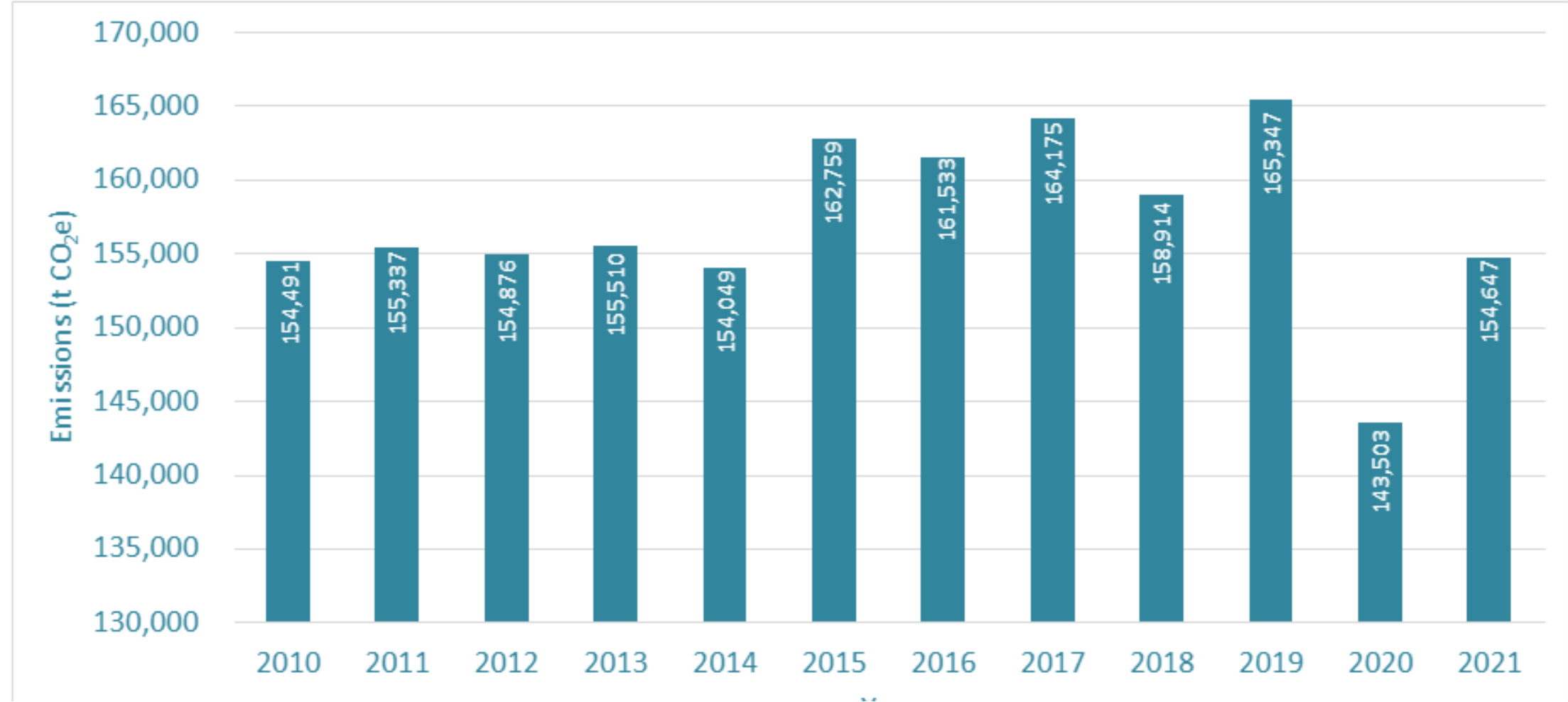
# TOTAL EMISSIONS

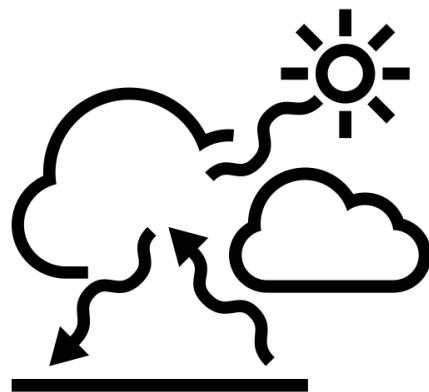
# EMISSION FACTOR UPDATES

An **emission factor** (EF) is a value that describes the rate at which a given activity releases greenhouse gases (GHGs) into the atmosphere.

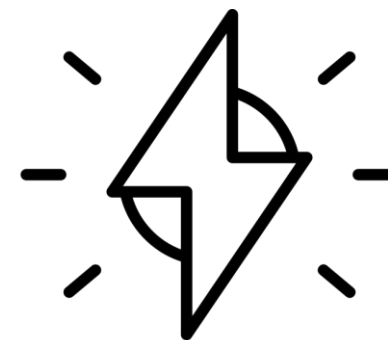

## What's changing?



- Reducing the Emissions Factor for gasoline light duty vehicles and light duty trucks.
- Hindcasting to 2016

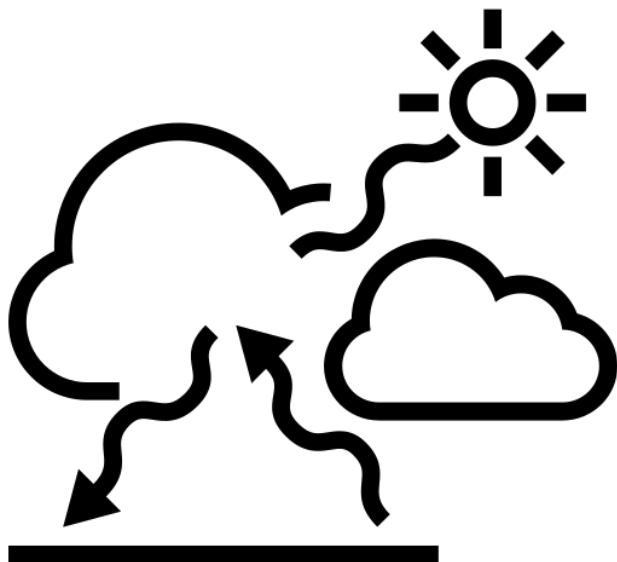
## Why is it changing?

- Align with Federal regulations and reports, and age of fleets
- Increase accuracy

## What does this mean for you?

- Slightly lower fleet emissions

# GLOBAL WARMING POTENTIALS



A **Global Warming Potential** is a measure of how much energy the emissions of 1 tonne of a greenhouse gas will absorb over a given period of time, relative to the emissions of 1 tonne of carbon dioxide (CO<sub>2</sub>)

**NEW POSITIONS IN THE  
CLEAN GOVERNMENT REPORTING TOOL (CGRT)**

# CONTEXT

A **position** is a location in CGRT where data is stored



**Fleet:** PSOs are using electricity and renewable natural gas (RNG)



**Paper:** PSOs are using non-wood fibre paper

CGRT does not have positions for:

- Mobile RNG
- Mobile electricity
- Alternative paper types

# WHAT WE HEARD

- Imminent need for accurate reporting of **offset-exempt** emissions from **electric buses** and **RNG buses**

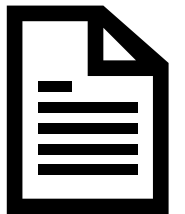


- **Mobile electricity:**

- Challenges in distinguishing from stationary electricity
- Excellent questions on accounting, implementation in CGRT



- Interest in more accurate reporting of **alternative paper types**

  - Natural Gas Mobile Use (existing category)
    - **Mobile – Natural Gas (R100)**
  - Electricity Mobile Use (new category)
    - **Mobile electricity BC – Integrated Grid – BC Hydro**
    - **Mobile electricity BC – Fort Nelson Grid**

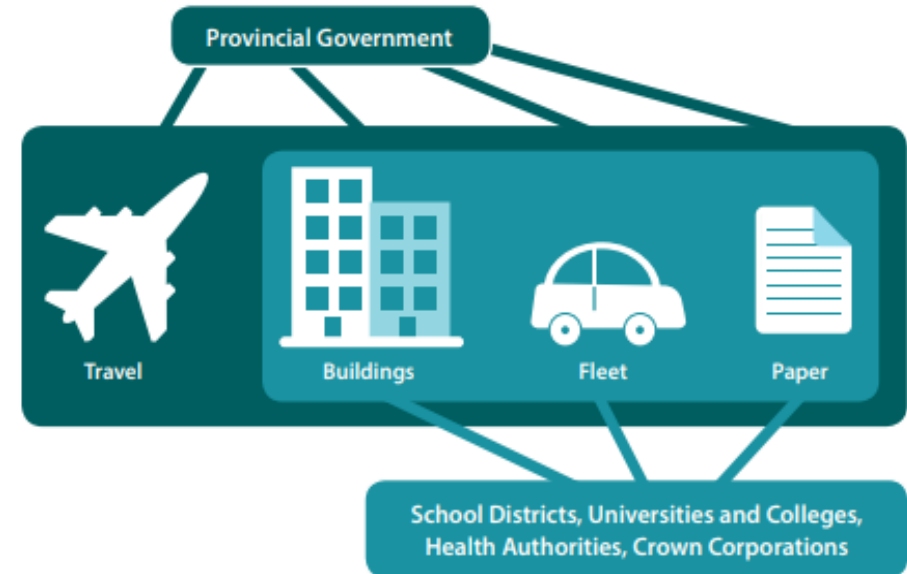
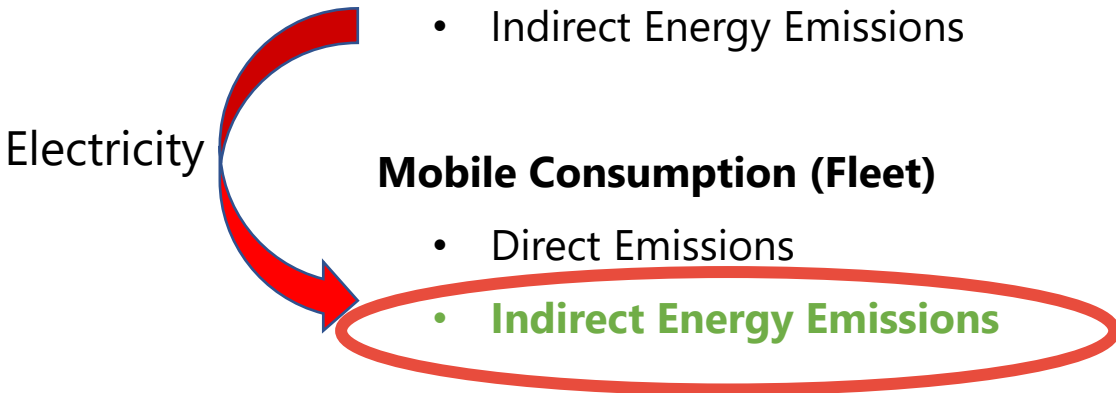
