The Early Resolution process will apply when family law cases are filed in the Surrey Registry or the Victoria Registry of the Provincial Court of BC.

Early resolution applies to cases about:

- parenting arrangements
- child support

- contact with a child
 - b guardianship of a child
- spousal support

- Participate in at least one consensual dispute resolution session (unless exempted) where you can try to resolve your issues and improve communication.
- If you go to court, you will start with a Family Management Conference.
