- (b) effective September 30, 2020, the Manufactured Forest Products Regulation, B.C. Reg. 240/2003, is amended as set out in the attached Schedule.

SCHEDULE

1 Section 1 of the Manufactured Forest Products Regulation, B.C. Reg. 240/2003, is amended

(a) by repealing subsection (1) (a),

(b) in subsection (1) (d) (v) by striking out everything before clause (A) and substituting the following:

(v) for timber that is not from the Coast Area, rough or planed, square or rectangular timbers that are no greater than 0.10 m² in cross-section area and that meet the following wane requirements: ,

(c) in subsection (1) (d) by adding the following subparagraphs:

(vi) for timber that is from the Coast Area and that is of any species other than western redcedar or cypress, rough or planed, square or rectangular timbers that are no greater than 0.10 m² in cross-section area and that meet the wane requirements set out in subparagraph (v) (A) to (C);

(vii) for timber that is from the Coast Area and that is of the species of western redcedar or cypress, rough or planed, square or rectangular timbers that are no greater than 0.10 m² in cross-section area and that are fully manufactured; , ***and***

(d) by adding the following subsection:

(1.1) In subsection (1) (d), “**Coast Area**” means the area that comprises

(a) the South Coast Forest Region established by section 6 (1) of the Administrative Boundaries Regulation, and

(b) the West Coast Forest Region established by section 8 (1) of the Administrative Boundaries Regulation.
