THAT the reserves established pursuant to Order in Council No. 33, approved January Sth, 1961, Order in Council 2122, approved August 20th, 1963, and Order in Council No. 1512, approved June 17th, 1963, be cancelled insofer as they relate to the area described hereunder:

AND TO FURTHER RECORDING THAT pursuant to the Nimeral Act and Placer-Mining Act and all other powers thereunto enabling no person may locate or mine upon the following described area in the Golden Mining Divinion for any mineral therein:-

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situated in the Rooteney Land District, more particularly described as follows:

- 1. All that portion of the watershed of the Columbia River which lies to the north of a straight line drawn due east and wast through a point on the left bank of the Columbia River, said point lying two miles downstream from the mouth of Birch Creek and to the south of a straight line drawn due east and west through Reach Hark 1012 and lying below the 1930 foot contour of elevation. Reserving thereout 5.T.L. 3769<sup>2</sup>.
- 2. All that portion of the watershed of the Columbia River which lies to the north of a straight line drawn due east and west through Banch Mark 1012 and to the south of a straight line drawn due east and west through the mouth of Mica Creek and lying below the 2200 foot contour of elevation.
- 3. Communing at the intersection of a straight line drawn due east and west through the wouth of Mice Creek with the wasterly boundary of S.T.L. 7278<sup>p</sup>; thence northwesterly in a straight line to the most southerly southeast corner of S.T.L. 2269<sup>p</sup>; thence westerly and northerly slong the southerly and westerly

boundaries to the most westerly northwest corner of said S.T.L. 2269°; thence northwesterly in a straight line to the most westerly southwest corner of S.T.L. 2299°; thence northerly slong the westerly boundary to the northwest corner of said S.T.L. 2299°; thence southeasterly in a straight line to the northeast corner of S.T.L. 1529°; thence southeasterly in a straight line to the intersection of a straight line drawn due east and west through the mouth of lics Creek with the easterly boundary of S.T.L. 11246°; thence due west in a straight line to the wasterly boundary of S.T.L. 1268°; being the point of commencement.
