


Manufactured Home Registry

Guide for completing a transportation application online to move a manufactured home - BC Registry application



Step: Log in to the BC Registry application

Prerequisite: You must have a new BC Registries (modernized application) account, add the Manufactured Home Registry product/service and have approved Qualified Supplier access as a lawyer/notary organization before you can submit a transport permit.

Follow these <u>training resources</u> to request Qualified Supplier access and refer to the BC Registries Manufactured Home Registry MHR webpage.

My Manufactured Home Registry

Search for manufactured homes, and search for personal property legal claims on manufactured homes.





My Asset Registries

Search for manufactured homes, and register or search for legal claims on personal property.

NOTE for Manufacturers and Home Dealers: you will only be able to register a transport permit if the home's registered location matches your dealer lot location information. Contact Registries staff if you need assistance.

Click 'Open' beside 'My Manufactured Home Registry' or 'My Asset Registries'

If you have access to both Personal Property Registry (PPR) and Manufactured Home Registry (MHR), this will state 'My Asset Registries'.



Step: Find the Manufactured Home Registration record

Throughout this guide, MHR stands for Manufactured Home Registry, MH indicates a manufactured home registration record.

Input the Manufactured Home Registration number and click the search icon (or press the enter key) to load the existing manufactured home registration record



Step: Open the Manufactured Home Registration record




Review the manufactured home registration record to confirm all of the current location, manufactured home details are all accurate.






Step: Transport Permit for moving within the same manufactured home park




Click the help icon (?) to view information on transport permits






Step: Transport Permit for moving to a new location

Select the location change type of Transport Permit.


Select the **Location Type** where the manufactured home is moving to:

Input the PID number, if available.

The system will search in the land titles system for this lot and populate the land description.



OR Input the legal land description manually:






Step: Transport Permit for moving to a new location



Input the new civic address where the manufactured home will be moving to

Note – you can overwrite the Canada Post mailing address if this is a rural location






Confirm the land lease or land ownership. Click Yes or No

If no, then:

Note: Written permission and tenancy agreements from the landowner may be required for the home to remain on the land.

Relocation of the home onto land that the homeowner does not own or hold a registered lease of 3 years or more may require additional permits from authorities such as the applicable Municipality, Regional District, First Nation, or Provincial Crown Land Office.





Step: Transport Permit for moving to a new location – provide tax certificate expiry date information

Click to input the tax certificate expiry date

4. Confirm Tax Certificate

A valid tax certificate is required; it must be issued from the tax authority with jurisdiction of the home, and must show that all local taxes have been paid for the current tax year. To confirm your tax certificate, enter the expiry date below.

NOTE FOR MANUFACTURERS and Home Dealers:

You do not need to provide any tax certificate information for newly manufactured homes.

Click Review and Confirm to go to the next screen





Click on the PDF icon to download and save or print out all pages of the Transport Permit.



Step: Transport Permit for moving a manufactured home

A report must be submitted to the Registrar within 3 days if either of the following apply:

 (a) The manufactured home is not moved before the transport permit expires, or

Manufactured Home Registration Number: 108118

(b) The home is permanently moved to a different location than what is specified on the transport permit.

- This permit expires 30 days after the date of issue. If the manufactured home is NOT MOVED within this time, you must report the physical location of the manufactured home within 3 days of expiration of the permit.
- This permit may be used for one (1) move only. A new permit must be obtained for subsequent moves.
- Upon leaving British Columbia, this home is Exempted from the Manufactured Home Act. The home is required to be re-registered under the same number if it re-enters the Province of British Columbia.
