Dear: Mr. Pedersen;

The letter is to inform you that an amendment to the Snowshoe Plateau/ Yanks Peak motorized recreation closure Section 58 (1)(b) of the *Forest and Range Practices Act (2005)* has been proposed.

This amendment would see a change in the “designated motorized route” to include the section of the Little Snowshoe Road and the “Hampton Trail” where they intersect with the Yanks Peak Trail (shown in black on the attached map). This amendment will allow public to access the Yanks Peak area via 3 trails, all of which are hard packed mining roads, and do not provide access to sensitive areas.

The perimeter border of the Section 58 Closure Area will not be affected by this amendment; the proposal is to identify three (3) additional sections to the “designated motorized route” only.

Signage indicating the regulation changes will be placed at determined locations in the area.
