



## ***District/Authority Scholarship Notification***

You have been named by your school or district as a **conditional winner** of a District/Authority Scholarship, valued at \$1,250, for the 2019/2020 school year.

### **Receiving Your Scholarship**

- After August 31, the Ministry of Education will use information reported by schools to confirm you have met the scholarship eligibility requirements.
- Scholarship vouchers are issued in October. They will be mailed to the last address reported to the Ministry of Education by your graduating school.
- You need to receive your voucher in the mail before you can start the process of redeeming your scholarship.
- Scholarships are not redeemed for current year graduates until after vouchers are mailed. Visit [www.gov.bc.ca/scholarshipsprogram](http://www.gov.bc.ca/scholarshipsprogram) for updates.

- Scholarship funds are reimbursed to you by cheque (not to your school) ***after*** you have provided the required proof of enrollment and tuition payment.

### ***What to do if you don't receive your voucher in October.***

- Check your **StudentTranscriptService** account to see if you are a confirmed winner.
- Check [www.gov.bc.ca/scholarships](http://www.gov.bc.ca/scholarships) for updates to see if vouchers have been mailed.
- Four weeks after vouchers are mailed, winners who did not receive their voucher can use the “**Declaration of Lost Scholarship Voucher**” form to redeem their scholarship. The form is available at [www.gov.bc.ca/scholarshipsprogram](http://www.gov.bc.ca/scholarshipsprogram).

### **Scholarship Expiry**

- You have five years, from the date of general issue, to use and redeem your scholarship. The expiry date is on your voucher.
