Mineral Titles Information Update

No. 37 - Coal Information and Data Reporting **Required Under the Coal Act**

The Coal Act (Act) and Coal Act Regulation (Regulation) set out requirements for clients to apply for coal licences and coal leases. Upon issuance of coal tenure, one of the requirements of a tenure holder is to submit annual coal information and data to the Province.

Section 8(1) of the Act requires that information and data must be submitted to the minister respecting the exploration, development and production of coal. A coal licence is valid for a term of one year from the date of its issue. To extend the term of the licence for a further one year term, an application must be made before the licence expires and the application must be accompanied by the prescribed rent, as well as the information and data required under section 8(1) of the Act. The same information and data required under section 8(1) is also required for leases and freehold coal annually, as described below.

Information and data must be submitted as follows:

- For a **licence** extension, with the application for extension;
- For a lease, on or before the anniversary date of the lease in each year;
- For a person exploring for or developing coal on **freehold land**, on or before March 31 in each year;
- For a **licence** or **lease** that expires, is surrendered or is cancelled, not more than 90 days after the date of the expiry, surrender or cancellation.

The specific information and data requirements are set out in section 3 of the Regulation. The information and data must be prepared by, or under the supervision of, a professional engineer or professional geoscientist qualified in the subject matter of the submission.

In the event of a discrepancy between this information and the provisions in the Mineral Tenure Act and Regulation, the provisions in the statute and regulations will apply.
