Act being Chapter 153 of the Revised Statutes of British Columbia 1960 and pursuant to Clause 14 of the said Tree Farm Licence Number 39 the following lands are hereby withdrawn from the lands described in Schedule "A" of the said Tree Farm Licence; that is to say, all and singular those certain parcels of land in Rupert Land District being more particularly shown outlined in red on the sketch attached hereto and described as follows:

"That part of Lot 549 (T.L. 4371), Rupert Land District, lying within the boundaries of the Machete Fractional Mineral Claim (Lot 1501); that part of Lot 553 (T.L. 4388), Rupert Land District, lying within the boundaries of the Happy Jack (Lot 1495), the Machete Fraction (Lot 1501) and the Contact No. 2 Mineral Claims and to the west of the westerly natural boundary of the Benson River."

and the lands so withdrawn are not and shall not be henceforth subject to or form any part of the said Tree Farm Licence.
