The undersigned has the honour to Teporti-

THAT the "Mineral Act Amendment Act 1944" and the "Placer-mining Act Amendment Act 1944" provide that the Lieutenant-Governor in Council may from time to time by order signed by the Minister place a reservation upon any lands specified in the order, or upon any minerals specified in the order; and thereupon no person shall during the continuance of the reservations have the right to enter, locate, prospect or mine upon the lands specified in the order or for any of the minerals specified in the order, or to exercise in relation thereto any of the rights conferred by the "Mineral Act" or the "Placer-mining Act":

AND THAT it is against the public interest that the soil or subsoil of any cemetery shall be disturbed by prospecting or mining operations:

THEREFORE, it is recommended that pursuant to the amending Acts aforesaid the undersigned be authorized to make an order placing a reservation upon all lands of existing cemeteries and the lands of any cemeteries which may be established pursuant to the provisions of the "Cemeteries" Act Chap. 33, R. S. 1936.
