

## SPAR Release 6.31.00 Summary

On August 18<sup>th</sup>, 2022 SPAR version 06.31.00 will be released in the SPAR production environment. This release contains changes to the [seedling request screen](#) and the [suitable seed/vegetative lot for CBST search screen](#).

### Seedling Request Screen Changes

1. The FTM funding code (Forests for Tomorrow MOF Admin) will no longer be used for ministry requests and will be replaced with the FIP (Forest Investment Program) code.
2. Two fields (Field Contact Name and Field Contact email/phone) have been added to the Additional Criteria section. These fields will appear on the Seedling Request Monitoring Report extract and the Seedling Request Extract.

### Suitable Seed/Vegetative Lot for CBST Search

The suitable seed/vegetative lot for CBST Search screen has been updated allow for SPAR users to search for seedlots that can fit in up to three different BEC variants. Please note that when using this screen to search for seedlots that fit multiple BEC variants, A class seedlots that fit one of the BEC variants may get screened out. As [per section 7.3 of the Chief Forester's Standards for Seed Use](#), SPAR users are still expected to use A class material for the purpose of establishing a stand (section 29 of FPRA) when possible.
