PENTICTON – The BC Coroners Service will hold an inquest into the death of Gordon Brent Amyotte.

Mr. Amyotte was in medical distress while in the custody of the Penticton RCMP. Despite medical treatment, he died May 28, 2010, at Penticton Regional Hospital.

The inquest is scheduled for Jan. 16-20, 2012. Presiding Coroner Mark Coleman and a jury will hear evidence from subpoenaed witnesses to determine and make public the facts surrounding this death. The jury will have the opportunity to make recommendations aimed at preventing deaths under similar circumstances in the future.
