DUNCAN – An inquest into the death of Derek Wayne Welton has been scheduled. Mr. Welton was shot during an incident with North Cowichan/Duncan RCMP. Despite medical treatment, he died on March 1, 2009, at Cowichan District Hospital.

The inquest is scheduled for Jan. 31–Feb. 4, 2011. Presiding coroner Rodrick MacKenzie and a jury will publicly hear evidence from subpoenaed witnesses in order to determine the facts surrounding the death. The jury will have the opportunity to make recommendations aimed at preventing deaths under similar circumstances in the future.
