## 2015 CNAR Data Reporting:

When filling out your 2015 CNAR, be sure to use the FINAL emission, offset and adjustment numbers found on your SMARTTool homepage. These numbers will be finalized by May 16 and are should be used for your 2015 reporting. Please ensure you verify these numbers after May 16th before submitting your CNAR.

## **Offset Payments**

Public Sector Organizations will receive their offset invoice the week of May 16. It will contain all necessary information to submit your payment. Please be aware that if you pay via Wire Transfer, \$15 will be added to you invoice to cover the additional charge for the transfer. Electronic Fund Transfers and cheque payments will have no additional fees.

#### Please note the following changes to the 2015 CNAR Process:

1) In previous years, the CNAR process required completion of two separate surveys. This year, there's one survey to complete with two parts: Part One represents the 'Actions' portion of the CNAR and will be appended to your overview document. Part Two collects data to be used for internal purposes only (i.e., Part Two will not be made public).

2) The CNAR Overview template now includes a section through which your organization agrees to have the Ministry of Environment retire offsets on behalf of your organization. The section simply makes explicit the process that the Ministry used last year. It's a more transparent process as well as providing the Ministry with more flexibility in the retirement of offsets.
