LIVESTOCK HOMESITE

Homesteads

Primary location of the farm where most livestock management occurs - location of main ranch or main barn, corrals, paddocks, barns, and feeding/watering facilities, as well as the farm residence.

? Non homestead
Location where livestock are present but related infrastructure is minimal - often only pasture fencing and watering. Used for pasturing livestock and is secondary to an operation's primary or homestead location.

LIVESTOCK INTENSITY

* Intensive facilities
Specialized structures designed for confined feeding at high stocking density

Non intensive
Non intensive barn, corrals, paddocks, field and pasture fencing

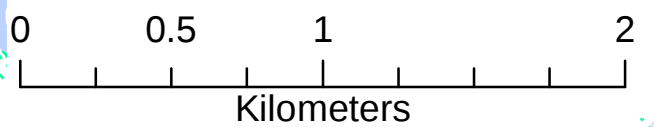

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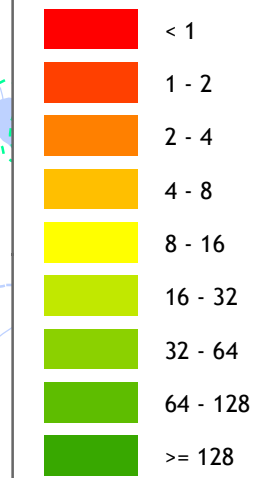
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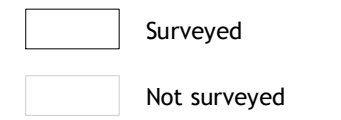

MAP 5 - ALR PARCEL SIZE

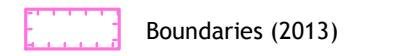
