Re: Road Use Permit Amendments and Terminations will Continue to be Submitted to Forest Districts until early March 2022

The Ministry of Forests, Lands, Natural Resource Opportunities, and Rural Development's (FLNRORD) Integrated Forestry Project (IFP) recently launched the <u>Natural Resource Online Services portal (NROS)</u>, a new online tool that will make submitting a wide variety of applications easier, faster, and more convenient. This release incorporates road use permits (RUP) into the Resource Roads System (RRS).

Currently, **new RUP applications** will continue be accepted through the NROS portal. **RUP applications for amendments and terminations** will continue to be submitted manually to forest districts per the current process. RUP amendments and terminations are now expected to be included in the NROS portal as of early March 2022, once the RUP data transfer has been completed.
