Small Scale Salvage, Forest License to Cut (FLTC), Data entry into RESULTS guidance document, November 2012, Resource Practices Branch.

This document is intended to provide clarification around opening category code selection for the entry of Small Scale Salvage (SSS), Forestry License to Cut, silviculture data into RESULTS. This document should be used in conjunction with the <u>Small Scale Salvage RESULTS submissions guide</u>

FLTC Data entry into RESULTS is guided by both free growing obligation and funding source. The three opening categories used to track SSS (FLTC) include Forest Tenure Levy (FTLEVY), Forest Tenure no Levy (FTNOLVY), and Site Plan Exempt areas under tenure (SPEX).

Determining whether a free growing obligation has been incurred is guided by <u>FPPR s.46</u>. In cases where a free growing obligation has been incurred, as per FPPR s.46, and a levy has been collected under the Forest Stand Management Fund (FSMF), use **FTLEVY** as the opening category code in RESULTS.

In cases where a free growing obligation has been incurred, as per FPPR s.46, and no levy has been collected, use **FTNOLVY** as the opening category code in RESULTS.

In cases where no free growing obligation exists, as per FPPR s.46, use **SPEX** as the opening category code in RESULTS.

It is important to note that **openings with silviculture obligations and openings without silviculture obligations cannot be tracked under the same opening in RESULTS**.

Please note that the Forest Tenure - Forest Stand Management (FTFSM) opening category should not be used to track small scale salvage forest licenses to cut. FTFSM is intended solely for **Non Replaceable Forest Licenses (NRFL)**, where the free growing obligations have been transferred to the government under the <u>FPC Act s. 71</u>, or Non-Replaceable licenses under <u>FRPA s.30</u> as well.
