- Small businesses impact every sector of the BC Jobs Plan
- Small business is a key driver of job creation and economic growth:
 - 98% of businesses in B.C. have fewer than 50 employees
 - Small businesses account for 31% of the province's GDP
 - Small businesses account for 86% of all provincial exporters
- Small business benefits all British Columbians through increased job creation, innovation and economic competitiveness.

• BC Jobs Plan progress made:

- Removed red tape
- Sponsored Small Business Roundtable's Awards
- Introduced Short-form Request for Proposals
- Launched LNG-Buy BC program
- Released Starting a Restaurant in B.C. guide
- Two more communities have joined BizPal

• Spotlight:

- B.C.'s Northeast saw a 3.9% increase in small businesses from 2008-2013
- Mainland/Southwest saw an addition of about 4,200 net new small businesses in a five-year period
- Small business confidence in B.C. continues to outpace the country





- Early insight from David Chilton during this growth
