Title: "2020 PSO Climate Change Accountability Report"

Organization: School District No. 28 (Quesnel)

Declaration statement: This Climate Change Accountability Report for the period January 1, 2020 to December 31, 2020 summarizes our emissions profile, the total offsets to reach net-zero emissions, the actions we have taken in 2020 to reduce our greenhouse gas emissions and our plans to continue reducing emissions in 2021 and beyond.

Overview:

In 2020, the District completed the demolition of its oldest and largest school reducing a large carbon footprint from the district. The District has been approved to receive 4 buses for the year which will release fewer emissions that the buses they are replacing. The District also implemented Papercut, a program designed to help reduce paper useage. Furthermore, the District has committed to a maintenance vehicle replacement program which will replace trucks with higher emissions with newer and more efficient vehicles.

In 2021, the District has been approved for a complete exterior envelope upgrade at Dragon Lake Elementary, which will increase the R-value, creating better energy efficiencies. The District is also approved to install a high efficiency boiler at Nazko Elementary which we anticipate to reduce gas consumption by up to 30%. Furthermore, the district will be replacing part of the roof at Parkland Elementary, increasing the R-value of that school.
