Re: Designation of Natural Resource Officers under the *Natural Resource Compliance Act* – Musqueam Indian Band

Designation of natural resource officers

1. Under section 2 (1) of the *Natural Resource Compliance Act*, I designate the following person employed by the Musqueam Indian Band, and party to the Seconded Agreement (herein called the “Agreement”) dated the 22nd day of April, 2022, identified in the list below as a natural resource officer:

Limitations on natural resource officers’ powers and duties

2. Pursuant to section 2 (2) of the *Natural Resource Compliance Act*, the natural resource officer designated in section 1 of this memorandum has the following limitations for the enactments listed in the table below:



Revocation of Designation

3. Pursuant to section 2 (2) and (3) of the *Natural Resource Compliance Act*, a designation as a natural resource officer under section 1 of this memorandum remains in effect until the earliest of the following:

- (a) April 30, 2024;
- (b) the termination of the Agreement;
- (c) the designation is rescinded by the Minister; or
- (d) the person designated ceases to be employed by the Musqueam Indian Band.
