




Tree Farm Licence 18 Recreation Map

NOTICE

Road Use
All access roads are radio controlled and monitored. Radio frequencies are posted at main and secondary road branches. Users without two-way radios should follow a radio equipped vehicle wherever possible.

The Clearwater area monitoring service ("Clearwater Answering") can be called on the CANFOR Office and Safety Channel (153.170 MHz). This service can be used to contact assistance in case of emergency.

Camping
Currently, a camping pass is not required for visitors camping overnight at Recreation Site campgrounds. Camping is on a 'first come first serve' basis.
Please keep the campsites clean and take your garbage when you leave.

Fishing Regulations
TFL 18 is located in Region 3 (Thompson-Nicola) Management Unit 3-39. Mandatory fishing regulations include quotas, closures, gear, bait, and boating restrictions.
Please consult the Freshwater Fishing Regulations Synopsis before fishing in any waterbody or watercourse. All boats and trailers coming from milfoil infested areas must be cleaned before entering the area.

Walk-In Lakes (Access Closures)
Walk-In Zones have been established around the following lakes located within or adjacent to TFL 18:
Constance, David, Deube, Downey (Jones), Earl, Edece, George, Goodwin, Loch Ness (Lost Girl Guide), Marshall, Neil, Rioux, Robinson, Smith, 2 Mile and Walter.

Snowmobiling
Where snowmobile routes follow active logging roads, the snow berm on one side of the road may be prepared along the right-of-way to allow snowmobile access.
Snowmobile Clubs are to discuss access with Canadian Forest Products managers at the beginning of each season.
All main road crossings will have posted signs.

Fires
Firewood is not provided in any recreation site. Use only dead and down trees for firewood. Campfires are only permitted at campsites with steel fire rings.
Never leave campfires unattended & please respect fire closures.
