# July\_, 2008 Interim Measures Agreement

THIS AGREEMENT dated for reference this 29 day of July , 2008

#### BETWEEN:

### Kwickentaineuk/Ab-Kwa-Mish First Nation

As represented by Chief Councillor Robert Chamberlin and Council
(the "(K-AFN)

#### AND

## Her Majesty the Queen in the Right of the Province of British Columbia

As represented by the Minister of Forests and Range)

(the "Government of British Columbia")

- Whereas, the K AFN is seeking an economic opportunity to further their interests
  of building houses for their community;
- Whereas, a number of community agencies are contributing to the community rebuild project and Ministry of Forests and Range would like to assist the K AFN

Now therefore the Parties agree as follows:

Relationship of this Interim Measure Agreement to the Kwieksutaineuk/Ab-Kwa-Mish Forestry Agreement

- This Agreement provides an additional economic opportunity pursuant to section 3.0
  of the Kwicksuminank/Ah-Kwa-Mish Forestry Agreement between K AFN and the
  Government of British Columbia signed April 5, 2004 (the "Forest Agreement").
- Except where this Agreement sets out terms that are different from the Forest Agreement, the terms and definitions of the Forest Agreement apply equally to this Agreement.

# Purpose:

- 1) The purpose of this Interim Measures Agreement is to:
  - a) Provide an interim measures opportunity to support K AFN participation in the forest sector in the short term while they pursue their longer term interests through their forest strategy and Treaty process
  - b) Encourage operational synergies with British Columbia Timber Sales and other licensees working in the K AFN asserted Traditional Territory
  - c) Provide for an economic development opportunity for K AFN that will assist in the development of residential buildings for the community by providing an invitation to K AFN for a non-replaceable forest licence in the Kingcome Timber Supply Area (TSA); and

# Invitation to Apply for a Non-Replaceable Forest Licence

- 2) After execution of this Agreement by the parties, the Minister of Forests and Range (the "Minister") will invite the K AFN to apply for a non-replaceable licence (the "Licence") for up to 4,100 m3 over five years in the Kingcome TSA under section 47.3 of the Forest Act and within the K AFN asserted traditional territory.
- 3) Any invitation to apply and any licence entered into as a result of an invitation under this Interim Measures Agreement are subject to the policies, regulations and statutes of British Columbia as amended from time to time.
- 4) The invitation to apply for the licence under this Interim Measures Agreement will contain terms and conditions required by the Minister.
- 5) An invitation will contain a condition that prior to K AFN making an application for the licence, K AFN will contact the Ministry of Forests and Range and the parties will endeavour to identify an operating area within K AFN asserted traditional territory.
- 6) A licence entered into as a result of the invitation to apply under this Interim Measures Agreement:
  - s) will be for a term no longer than five years, as determined by the Minister,
  - will contain other terms and conditions required by law, including the condition that K AFN must comply with this Interim Measures agreement and the K AFN Forest Agreement dated April 5, 2004;
  - c) will include a term that K AFN may not dispose of the licence except in

## accordance with the Forest Act;

- d) will include other terms and conditions as may be required by the regional executive director.
- An invitation to apply for a licence (an "invitation") and any licence entered into as a result of the invitation to apply under this Interim Measures Agreement may be combined with a tenure opportunity included in any other agreement in accordance with the Forest Act.

### Amendments

8) Any alteration or amendment to the terms and conditions of this Interim Measures Agreement must be in writing and duly executed by the parties.

### Term

- This Interim Measures Agreement will take effect on the date on which the last party has executed it.
- 10) This Interim Measures Agreement will be terminated on the occurrence of the carliest of:
  - a) five years from the date this Interim Measures Agreement is executed; or,
  - b) the mutual agreement of the parties; or
  - c) written notice of withdrawal to the Interim Measures Agreement by either Party, which will take effect 90 days following receipt of the notice by the other Party; or,
  - d) the date on which the Government of British Columbia cancels the licence under this Interim Measures Agreement pursuant to Section 12
- 11) If the K AFN Forest Agreement dated April 5, 2004 is terminated, the consultation processes that were set out in Section 4 and 5 of the Forest Agreement are incorporated into this Agreement and will continue to be used by the parties for as long as this Agreement is in effect between the parties.
- 12) Without limiting the actions that may be taken by the Minister of Forest and Range or by the Government of British Columbia, the Minister or a person authorized by the Minister may suspend, or cancel the licence entered into as a result of the invitation under this Interim Measures agreement, if the Minister or a person authorized by the Minister determines that K AFN is not in compliance with this Interim Measures Agreement or the K AFN Forest Agreement dated April 5, 2004.
