Dear Service Provider,

We are pleased to inform you that the Call for Responses for Sexual Assault Centers is now open on BC Bid. The opportunity will be posted for 6 weeks and will close on Friday, August 18, 2023, at 2:00 pm (PST).

This Call for Responses (CFR) is intended to establish funding for a Sexual Assault Center (Centre) to provide integrated and co-located services in the high population and demand areas of: Victoria and the Capital Regional District, Prince George, Surrey, Vancouver, and their surrounding areas, and one Centre in either Kamloops, Vernon, or Kelowna. These Centers will provide support services for survivors of sexual assault and are intended to provide a dedicated space for community and system partners to provide forensic and medical exams, and police interviews in a trauma-informed environment.

To provide further details and guidance on using BC Bid and developing an application, the Community Safety and Crime Prevention Branch will be hosting a virtual information meeting on:

Attendance at this session is optional. The session will provide an overview of the procurement and information on how to apply. If you are unable to attend the session, you will also be able to access all of the materials (including notes on questions and responses) through <u>BC Bid</u>.
